\*Cleaning frequency recommendations are guidelines only. Actual cleaning frequency will depend upon humidity, degree of water hardness, shower temperature and other variables. In cases with extremely high silica content, it may be helpful to squeegee as needed between cleanings.

General precautions: avoid abrasive cleaners, such as Ajax, Comet, rouge or cerium oxide; hydrofluoric and phosphoric acid are corrosive to the coated surface and shouldn't be used; don't use abrasive brushes, razor blades or sharp objects which may scratch the coating.
